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NOTICE OF DETERMINATION OR JUDGMENT OF GUILT

The Florida Bar files this Notice of Determination or Judgment of Guilt under Rule Regulating The Florida Bar 3-7.2(f) and says:

1. Respondent, Jason Alan Wiles is a member of The Florida Bar, admitted on December 9, 2006.

2. On July 18, 2023, respondent was arrested for Battery on a Person Over 65, a Third-Degree Felony, A copy of the Charging Affidavit is attached as Exhibit A.

3. On August 14, 2023, respondent was charged by information with one count of actually and intentionally touching or striking a person 65 years of age or older, or intentionally causing bodily harm to a person 65 years of age or older, , a Third-Degree Felony, and one count of willfully and maliciously, injuring or damaging, or placing graffiti thereon or

committing an act of vandalism to a cell phone, , a Second-Degree Misdemeanor. A copy of the Information is attached as Exhibit B.

4. On May 28, 2024, respondent pleaded nolo contendere to one count of Felony Battery, a Third-Degree Felony, in violation of §784.041(1), Fla. Stat. and one count of Criminal Mischief, a Second-Degree Misdemeanor, in violation of §806.13(1)(b)1, Fla. Stat. He was sentenced to 36 months' probation under the supervision of the Department of Corrections on Count I and time served on Count II. A copy of the Plea and Order of Probation is attached as Composite Exhibit C.

5. Adjudication of guilt was withheld by the court. A copy of the Judgment has been attached as Exhibit D.

6. On April 8, 2025, the court, entered an order terminating respondent's probation, pursuant to section 948.04, Florida Statutes.

7. Respondent failed to notify the executive director of The Florida Bar of the charges within 10 days of the filing of the indictment or information as required by Rule 3-7.2(c).

The Florida Bar respectfully requests that this Court enter an order:

A. Finding the respondent guilty of violating R. Regulating Fla. Bar 3.4-3 (Misconduct and Minor Misconduct), 3-4.4 (Criminal Misconduct), 3-

7.2(c) (Notice of Institution of Felony Criminal Charges), 4-8.4(b) (A lawyer shall not commit a criminal act that reflects adversely on the lawyer's honesty, trustworthiness or fitness as a lawyer in other respects.);

B. Suspending the respondent under Rule of Regulating The Florida Bar 3-7.2(f);

C. Ordering the respondent to provide a copy of the suspension order to all clients; opposing counsel; co-counsel; courts, tribunals, or adjudicative agencies before which the respondent is counsel of record; and state, federal, or administrative bars of which the respondent is a member as required by R. Regulating Fla. Bar 3-5.1(h);

D. Ordering the respondent to provide staff counsel with the affidavit required by R. Regulating Fla. Bar 3-5.1(h) listing the names and addresses of all persons and entities provided with the suspension order within 30 days after receipt of this Court's order; and

E. Appointing or directing the appointment of a referee to conduct a hearing on sanctions under R. Regulating Fla. Bar 3-7.2(h).
