Dear Ms. Blake:

Pursuant to the order of the Supreme Court of Florida dated August 7, 2023, you were suspended from the practice of law for a period of 1 year. The effective date of the suspension is September 6, 2023. The filing of a motion for rehearing does not alter the effective date of the suspension. Because the suspension is for a period of time greater than 90 days, you must petition for reinstatement after the suspension has ended, if you wish to resume the practice of law in Florida. Rule 3-7.10 outlines the procedure and considerations for reinstatement. The court's order also assessed costs in the amount of \$1,250.00. Your costs are due in this office no later than September 21, 2023. A Failure to Pay Notice providing important information relating to cost assessments is enclosed. If you are interested in being on a payment plan, and you qualify under the Delinquent Costs paragraph in the attached Failure to Pay Notice, please contact our office immediately.

You must follow the provisions of Rule 3-5.1(h). A copy of the order must be immediately provided to clients, opposing counsel, and certain courts, and you must provide an affidavit to us verifying that this has been done. A form affidavit is enclosed. Please note, providing a copy of the order to the clerk's office does not satisfy this rule. You must provide a copy of the order to the presiding judge. The executed affidavit must be provided to this office within 30 days of the court order **to wit**: September 6, 2023. 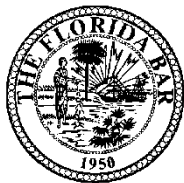
