NOTICE OF JUDGMENT OF GUILT

The Florida Bar files this Notice of Judgment of Guilt under Rule
Regulating The Florida Bar 3-7.2(f) and says:

1. Respondent is a member of The Florida Bar, admitted on
January 24, 2011.
2. On December 4, 2023, respondent was arrested by the
Jacksonville Sheriff's Office for Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer,
Resisting Officer with Violence, Trespass on Property of Another and
Defies Order to Leave, and Disorderly Intoxication. Thereafter, on
December 22, 2023, respondent was charged by information with Resisting
Officer with Violence, Trespass, and Disorderly Intoxication. See
Composite Exhibit A.

3. On May 31, 2024, respondent was found guilty, after a jury trial, of (Count 1) Resisting an Officer with Violence in violation of Fla. Stat. § 843.01, a third-degree felony, (Count 2) Trespass in violation of Fla. Stat. § 810.09, a first-degree misdemeanor, and (Count 3) Disorderly Intoxication in violation of Fla. Stat. § 856.011(1), a second-degree misdemeanor. A copy of the Verdict Sheets are attached as **Composite Exhibit B**.

4. On January 17, 2025, respondent was sentenced on Count 1 to 18 months' probation under the supervision of the Department of Corrections. Adjudication was withheld as to Counts 2 and 3, with unsupervised probation for a period of 1 day. A copy of the Judgment and Sentence is attached as **Exhibit C**.

5. The Florida Bar respectfully requests that this Court enter an order:

A. Finding the respondent guilty of violating R. Regulating Fla. Bar 3-4.3 (Misconduct and Minor Misconduct), 3-4.4 (Criminal Misconduct), and 4-8.4(b) (A lawyer shall not commit a criminal act that reflects adversely on the lawyer's honesty, trustworthiness or fitness as a lawyer in other respects.);

B. Suspending the respondent under Rule of Regulating The Florida Bar 3-7.2(f);

C. Ordering the respondent to provide a copy of the suspension order to all clients; opposing counsel; co-counsel; courts, tribunals, or adjudicative agencies before which the respondent is counsel of record; and state, federal, or administrative bars of which the respondent is a member as required by R. Regulating Fla. Bar 3-5.1(h);

D. Ordering the respondent to provide staff counsel with the affidavit required by R. Regulating Fla. Bar 3-5.1(h) listing the names and addresses of all persons and entities provided with the suspension order within 30 days after receipt of this Court's order; and

E. Appointing or directing the appointment of a referee to conduct a hearing on sanctions under R. Regulating Fla. Bar 3-7.2(h).
