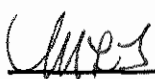
STIPULATION FOR PERMANENT INJUNCTION

WHEREAS the parties hereto, stipulate and agree to submit to the jurisdiction of the Supreme Court of Florida and stipulate and agree as follows:

WHEREAS The Florida Bar and Respondents are willing to settle and conclude this matter if the Supreme Court of Florida will agree to the settlement and enter the injunction set forth below, The Florida Bar and Respondents jointly stipulate and agree as follows:

1. That Respondent Ileana Miranda ("Respondent Miranda"), at all times material herein, was not and is not a member of The Florida Bar or of


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any other United States jurisdiction and was not licensed to engage in the practice of law in the State of Florida.

2. That Respondent IM Immigration & Notary Services, LLC, a Florida Limited Liability Company, all times material herein, was not and is not authorized to engage in the practice of law in the State of Florida.

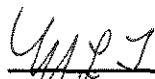
3. That Respondent Miranda, all times material herein, was the manager of Respondent IM Immigration & Notary Services, LLC and is authorized to enter into this stipulated injunction on behalf of the entity.

4. That Respondent Miranda held herself as capable of giving advice on immigration law and preparing immigration forms, has given legal advice on immigration law, and has prepared pleadings and immigration forms for others.

5. That Respondents agree that an injunction in this case shall issue permanently and perpetually enjoining Respondents and any employees or persons acting in concert with Respondents from engaging in the following activities in or from Florida:

A. Expressly or impliedly holding themselves or the business out as an attorney service or using any title that would lead the public to believe persons employed at or associated with Respondents are licensed


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to practice law in Florida.

B. Using a business name that directly or indirectly implies that the business is a law office.

C. Holding out to the public that Respondents are immigration experts or specialists or as being an expert or specialist regarding any area of law.

D. Offering paralegal services directly to the public.

E. Holding out to the public that Respondents are qualified to provide legal services.

F. Providing legal advice or legal services to any individual or business.

G. Advising persons or entities of their rights, duties, and any legal remedy that might be available to them.

H. Providing personal legal assistance to self-represented persons in the preparation of legal documents that goes beyond selling forms, typing forms, or providing written information.

I. Advising persons and entities of their rights, duties, and responsibilities under Florida law, or federal law, including advising persons and entities as to various immigration benefits or statuses or the forms or


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procedures needed to obtain those benefits or statuses.

J. Advising persons and entities as to which immigration form or application is best suited to their needs, how to fill out the form or application, or what supporting documentation should accompany the form or application.

K. Obtaining information verbally from another person for completion of immigration forms.

L. Editing substantive information obtained in writing from another person for completion of immigration forms.

M. Holding out to the public in such a manner that the public places reliance on Respondents to properly prepare legal forms including but not limited to immigration forms.

N. Explaining to third parties the legal significance of any legal document that affects that person or entity's important rights under the law.

O. Corresponding with parties or attorneys of parties as the representative of another relating to legal matters.

P. Having direct contact with another in the nature of consultation, explanation, recommendation, advice, or assistance, in relation to any legal remedy or course of action.


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Q. Representing to the public, either personally or by use of advertisement, that Respondents or any person employed by or acting in concert with them are capable of providing or are offering to the public legal services, legal advice, or personal legal assistance regarding immigration and naturalization matters or any other legal matters.

R. Representing to the public, either personally or by use of advertisement, the suggestion that any services directly offered by Respondents are the equivalent of or a substitute for the services of an attorney.

S. Appearing at judicial or quasi-judicial proceedings on behalf of another person.

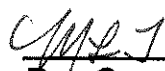
T. Advising another person of what to say or do at an immigration hearing or interview, or at any other judicial proceeding or quasi-judicial proceeding.

U. Soliciting or receiving attorney's fees or fees for legal services.

V. Stating or implying that Respondents have an attorney working for them or with them.

W. Allowing members of the public to rely on Respondents to


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properly prepare legal forms or legal documents affecting individuals' legal rights.

X. Otherwise directly or indirectly, through other persons, engaging in the practice of law in the State of Florida until licensed to do so.

6. Respondent Miranda agrees to immediately stop holding out Respondent IM Immigration & Notary Services, LLC as providing legal services to the public.

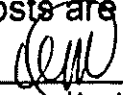
7. Respondents acknowledge that a power of attorney to act as a person's agent does not authorize the agent to act as the person's attorney in the State of Florida.

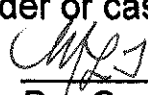
8. Respondents are not making any admissions of guilt by signing this Stipulation.

9. Respondents agree to pay the following costs incurred by The Florida Bar in the investigation of this matter:

10. Costs are to be paid by money order or cashier's check within


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60 days from the date of the Supreme Court of Florida's order approving this Stipulation.

11. Respondents acknowledge and agree that The Florida Bar is a governmental unit, that the costs imposed against them herein are sufficiently, for the purpose of bankruptcy law, in the nature of a fine, forfeiture or penalty and, therefore, are not dischargeable.

12. WHEREFORE, Respondents hereby agree they are prohibited by Florida law from engaging in the unlicensed practice of law in accordance with the terms of the foregoing Stipulation. This Stipulation will apply with equal force to any business or businesses that Respondents open or operate in Florida. Further, it applies to Respondent Miranda individually, even if employed by another similar business.

13. Respondents agree that every present and future employee of any business or service associated with Respondents, and all persons acting in concert with Respondents, will be provided with a copy of this Stipulation by Respondent Miranda, and will be instructed by Respondent Miranda to act in accordance with this Stipulation.

14. If Respondent Miranda engages in any conduct enjoined herein, she may be found in indirect criminal contempt of the Supreme


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Court of Florida for the unlicensed practice of law in this state.
