**GRIEVANCE COMMITTEE FINDING OF NON-COMPLIANCE AND
CONTEMPT**

On September 20, 2023, pursuant to Rule 3-7.11(f), Rules Regulating The Florida Bar, the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit Grievance Committee "A" considered whether to issue a Finding of Non-Compliance and Finding of Contempt and made the following findings:

1. On June 20, 2023, following respondent's failure to provide complete trust account records, The Florida Bar's staff investigator served respondent, via email, with a Subpoena Duces Tecum requiring respondent to produce specific trust account records to The Florida Bar by July 5, 2023. A copy of the served subpoena is attached hereto as Exhibit "A."
2. Thereafter, respondent failed to fully comply with The Florida Bar's subpoena.

3. Respondent spoke with the bar's auditor who advised respondent that the bar was doing a compliance audit and clarified the specific documents required and further granted respondent an extension until July 20, 2023, to comply with the subpoena. A copy of respondent's email confirming his request for a continuance while speaking with the bar's auditor is attached hereto as Exhibit "B."

4. Respondent again failed to fully comply with The Florida Bar's subpoena.

5. When bar counsel requested his response, respondent first indicated that he would provide the required documents by July 28, 2023, and then by August 9, 2023. A copy of email correspondence dated July 24, 2023, through August 4, 2023, between bar counsel and respondent, is attached hereto as Exhibit "C."

6. Thereafter, respondent again failed to fully respond to The Florida Bar's subpoena and failed to provide an adequate explanation for his failure to comply with a duly issued subpoena.

7. Respondent was given notice that on September 20, 2023, the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit Grievance Committee "A" would hold a hearing on the Request for Issuance of Notice of Non-Compliance and Finding of Contempt. A copy of the Notice of Hearing and the Request for Issuance

of Notice of Non-Compliance and Finding of Contempt, without previously listed/provided exhibits, is attached hereto as Exhibit "D."

8. Respondent made no written response to the Request for Issuance of Notice of Non-Compliance and Finding of Contempt.

9. The grievance committee found that respondent failed to show good cause for failing to respond to a duly issued grievance committee subpoena and that the non-compliance was willful.

10. The grievance committee found respondent to be in contempt and requested The Florida Bar to file a Petition for Contempt and Order to Show Cause with the Supreme Court.
