**STIPULATION**

WHEREAS, the parties hereto, stipulate and agree to submit to the jurisdiction of the Supreme Court of Florida, and

WHEREAS, The Florida Bar and Respondent are willing to settle and conclude this matter if the Supreme Court of Florida will agree to the settlement and enter the injunction set forth below, The Florida Bar and Respondent jointly stipulate and agree as follows:

1. That Respondent, JEFFREY HIRSCHKORN, at all times material herein, was not and is not a member of The Florida Bar, and was not licensed to engage in the practice of law in the State of Florida.

2. That Respondent agrees an injunction shall issue enjoining Respondent from:

A. Giving advice to and/or counseling other persons regarding their rights, duties, or responsibilities under federal or state law;

B. Construing and/or interpreting the legal effect of state or federal law and statutes for the purpose of advising other persons regarding their rights, duties, or responsibilities under the law;

C. Advising individuals about possible legal remedies and courses of action with regard to any legal matter that would affect their procedural and substantive rights, duties, and privileges under the law except when authorized to do so before administrative agency or before an administrative hearing officer;

D. Allowing members of the public to rely on Respondent to properly prepare legal forms or legal documents affecting the legal rights of individuals and entities;

E. Answering legal questions presented by any member of the public;

F. Conducting legal research on behalf of any member of the public;

G. Selecting or suggesting that a third party use a particular legal form or document, or use particular language in a particular

legal form or document;

H. Referring to himself as a "paralegal" unless Respondent is working under the direct supervision of an attorney according to Rules Regulating The Florida Bar 10-2.1(h);

I. Representing to the public that he is capable of advising and handling matters requiring legal skills;

J. Advertising in any fashion which may lead a reasonable lay person to believe Respondent offers legal services, legal advice, or personal legal assistance to the public;

K. Corresponding with or communicating with other individuals or entities, their attorneys, or with the court, directly or indirectly, as the representative or spokesperson of another person when such communications concern the important legal rights of others;

L. Conducting settlement negotiations on behalf of another person in a legal matter, or advising a customer regarding settlement of a legal matter;

M. Preparing, composing, or drafting pleadings, motions, agreements, contracts, or other legal documents for another person, even when those documents are to be signed "pro se" by the other

person.

N. In offering the sale and typing of legal forms to the public as a nonlawyer, Respondent affirmatively agrees that:

- 1) Respondent will only type information provided by a customer into the blanks on a form and will not make suggestions or recommendations regarding the contents of the legal document, or the language to be used in the completion of the blanks on the form;
- 2) If assisting a customer in the completion of blanks on a Florida Supreme Court Approved Form, Respondent is permitted to engage in limited oral communications in order to elicit the factual information necessary to fill in the blanks in the form (Rule 10-2.2(a), Rules Regulating The Florida Bar);
- 3) If assisting a customer in completion of blanks on a legal form which is not a Florida Supreme Court Approved Form, Respondent will not verbally take the information from the customer to complete the

form, but will take the information in writing and follow all requirements as set out in Rule 10-2.2(b)(1), Rules Regulating The Florida Bar;

- 4) Respondent will not answer a customer's or other person's questions about the content or effect of any legal form;
- 5) Respondent will not explain the differences in various legal forms and pleadings to customers or others;
- 6) Respondent will not instruct or advise customers or others which legal forms are necessary for various legal proceedings, nor select the proper form for the customer;
- 7) Respondents will not correct any errors or omissions made by a customer in providing their information to be placed into any legal form; and/or
- 8) Respondents will not modify, edit, or add to the preprinted wording of any legal form in order to tailor the form to the specific circumstances of a
