**GRIEVANCE COMMITTEE FINDING OF NON-COMPLIANCE AND
FAILURE TO RESPOND TO OFFICIAL BAR INQUIRY AND
CONTEMPT**

On November 16, 2023, pursuant to Rule 3-7.11(f), Rules Regulating The Florida Bar, the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit Grievance Committee "E" considered whether to issue a Finding of Non-Compliance and Failure to Respond to Official Bar Inquiry and Finding of Contempt and made the following findings:

1. On January 26, 2023, respondent was sent a letter by regular U.S. Mail to respondent's record bar address advising of a complaint in this case and was requested to respond by February 10, 2023. A copy of the letter is attached hereto as "Exhibit A".

2. Respondent failed to respond to The Florida Bar as requested in the letter of January 26, 2023.

3. On February 16, 2023, respondent was sent another letter, by regular U.S. Mail to respondent's record bar address, advising of a complaint in this case

and was requested to respond by February 27, 2023. A copy of the letter is attached hereto as "Exhibit B".

4. Respondent failed to respond to The Florida Bar as requested in the letter of February 16, 2023.

5. On March 3, 2023, respondent was sent third letter, by regular U.S. Mail to respondent's record bar address, by regular U.S. Mail to respondent's alternative address, and by email to respondent's record bar email address, advising of a complaint in this case and was requested to respond by March 13, 2023. A copy of the email is attached hereto as "Exhibit C".

6. On March 13, 2023, respondent responded to The Florida Bar as requested in the email of March 3, 2023. A copy of the response is attached hereto as "Exhibit D".

7. After untimely responding to the bar's initial inquiries concerning this matter, respondent was sent a written request for additional information from the bar to respondent's record bar email address on August 28, 2023, and was requested to respond by September 7, 2023. A copy of the email is attached hereto as "Exhibit E".

8. Respondent failed to respond to The Florida Bar as requested in the letter of August 28, 2023.

9. On September 14, 2023, respondent was sent a second letter by email to respondent's record bar email address advising of the request for more information in this case and was requested to respond by September 26, 2023. A copy of the email is attached hereto as "Exhibit F".

10. On October 25, 2023, respondent was given notice that on November 16, 2023, the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit Grievance Committee "E" would hold a hearing on the Request for Issuance of Notice of Non-Compliance and Finding of Contempt. A copy of the Notice of Hearing and the Request for Issuance of Notice of Non-Compliance and Finding of Contempt are attached hereto as "Exhibit G".

11. The notice was sent via regular U.S. Mail to respondent's record bar address and to respondent's alternative address; by Certified Mail, Return Receipt Requested, to respondent's record bar address and to respondent's alternative address; and by email to respondent's record bar email address.

12. On October 26, 2023, bar counsel and respondent engaged in email correspondence wherein bar counsel further explained what inquiries were outstanding. A copy of the email is attached hereto as "Exhibit H".

13. On November 7, 2023, bar counsel sent another email to respondent wherein bar counsel outlined and attached the outstanding inquiries, and further explained the process of the hearing on the Request for Issuance of Notice of Non-

Compliance and Finding of Contempt. A copy of the email is attached hereto as “Exhibit I”.

14. On November 8, 2023, after respondent called The Florida Bar with additional questions, bar counsel called respondent on his record bar phone number and his cell phone number, without success. Bar counsel followed up the attempts to reach respondent with an email. A copy of the email is attached hereto as “Exhibit J”.

15. On November 9, 2023, bar counsel again called respondent on his cell phone number, without success. Bar counsel followed up with an email outlining and attaching the outstanding inquiries, and further explained the process of the hearing on the Request for Issuance of Notice of Non-Compliance and Finding of Contempt and the subsequent petition for contempt and order to show cause. A copy of the email is attached hereto as “Exhibit K”.

16. Respondent made no response to the Request for Issuance of Notice of Non-Compliance and Finding of Contempt.

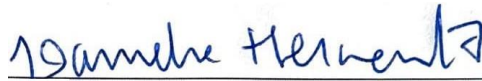
17. As of the date of this Finding of Non-Compliance and Failure to Respond to Official Bar Inquiry and Contempt, respondent has failed to respond to the official bar inquiries dated August 28, 2023 and September 14, 2023.

18. The Grievance Committee found that respondent failed to show good cause for failing to respond to the official bar inquiries and that the non-compliance was willful.

19. The Grievance Committee found respondent to be in contempt and requested The Florida Bar to file a Petition for Contempt and Order to Show Cause with the Supreme Court.

Complaint: Hubble Losson

PART 3

Dear Florida Bar,

On November 21st, 2022 I hired Hubbell Losson to represent me on misdemeanor/felony charges stemming from a traffic violation in Pinellas County, FL. I paid him \$2,500.00 prior to my arraignment as mutually agreed upon to officially hire him as my attorney throughout the entirety of this court case. Hubbell Losson's advertised rate for all new clients is \$5,000.00.

Hubbell Losson stated that he only asks for half payment out of his total required attorney retainer fee upfront (\$2,500.00 out of \$5,000.00), as long as the client promises prompt payment of the remaining half (\$2,500.00) prior to the end of all the legal proceedings on a respective case. I made good on my end of the agreement, starting on November 21, 2022 when I paid \$2,500.00 the morning before my arraignment, and again on December 1, 2022 when I paid him the remaining half of the total retainer. I have receipts for both of these payments sent to Hubbell Losson via VenMo and these are attached with corresponding screenshots from Green State Credit Union – proving these deductions taken from my checking account. (1)

Mr. Losson never provided me with a written agreement providing the terms of the engagement.

The appearance at the arraignment would be the only time Mr Losson met with me over the course of this entire event. I continued to text message and call regarding my case and despite promises to meet with me, all of the suggested times were not followed up upon by Mr Lawson. The only time we spoke after the arraignment was for him to tell me that after Thanksgiving, we would talk about what he learned from the Prosecutor. On the rare occasion he answered my texts over that next week post Thanksgiving, he assured me he would meet with me, and then not follow through. I had need for both criminal traffic court on December 12th, and then felony court on December 19th. I was becoming extremely nervous.

Finally, on the weekend prior to my Criminal traffic court hearing, I attempted to reach Mr Losson to no avail. In panic on Sunday night before the hearing Monday morning, I sent him the details of the hearing, reminding him of the time and got assurance he would be there. He finally texted me back " No problem I will take care of that for you " (2). On Monday he was not at the court. I called him 9 times while waiting for my case to be called. I came to the conclusion he had blocked my phone. (3)I faced the judge alone, and learned that Mr Losson had never provided documentation of Notice of Appearance. Without understanding what the Judge was offering me, I was scheduled for a non-jury trial on in February next year. The documents say I plead not guilty, but I am unsure how that was the conclusion, as she asked if I wanted the matter extended ,and I said yes.

I called him after court and he did not respond. I was stunned. On Tuesday, and Wednesday following, I called him throughout the day. He never responded. I went to his office and the door was locked though I sensed he was there. He was nowhere to be found. I read on an online review on 12/14 that the identical scenario was playing out for another client of his who was arrested for non-appearance in court. He said Mr Losson had failed to return his calls, properly represent him, and that his calls were blocked. He stated he filed a complaint with the Florida Bar, warning others not to use him. (4) I was now beyond panicked.

With only 3 business days before my felony case I called Mr Losson all day long. NOTHING. I reached out to my father for advice. Wednesday evening my father looked into the case online and realized Mr Losson had filed no documentation with the court as being my lawyer. In fact, no notice of appearance was ever filed by him. As my preliminary hearing was now only days away, I further realized Mr Losson had not only never talked to the prosecutor, he never filed any pleadings on my behalf nor advised me on the course forward. Nothing.

My father called Mr Losson at 6:57 pm on Wednesday 12/15. According to him, Mr Losson was immediately belligerent and seemed incapacitated to some degree, especially regarding having missed the traffic court date. My father sensed deeper issues and asked Mr Losson if he was a member in good standing of the Florida Bar. On a speaker phone with another witness, (Jana Bonderud my mother) his exact answer was " well that is a little screwy right now ".

Complaint: Hubble Losson

Sensing that we had now almost no time for proper legal representation, my father requested Mr Losson step aside from the case and refund our \$ 5,000.00. Mr Losson stated "I can't right now, I don't have it ". After my father demanded it ,Mr Losson hung up the phone. He called back quickly, and this time my Dad added me to the line. Losson said he was sorry for hanging up . My father directly asked him how he can represent me if his standing with the Bar is "screwy" ? Mr Lawson said I FUC__ING TOLD YOU IT'S IT'S A LITTLE SCREWY BUT FINE " . My father said- that is not what you told me and Mr Losson again hung up. Later that night , Losson called my father again, leaving an apologetic rambling voicemail stating he would be there on the 19th. He also said he would call me the next day- and did not.(5)

Given the dire circumstances, we reached out to my uncle, Andrew Bonderud , an attorney in Jacksonville, FL. As Losson had not called me even after the calls the night before, On Thursday afternoon December 15th 2022, after not receiving the promised call from the voice mail the night before , Attorney Andrew Bonderud ,my father and I called Mr Losson. He became immediately defensive and unprofessional on the call. Andrew talked about the missed court date and he denied either knowledge of it, or understanding that he was to be there. Andrew shared that we had text messages reflecting his understanding and agreement " to take care of it " at the criminal court hearing. Mt Losson then said "ok, yes I can still help, what was the outcome ?". Andrew began to tell him that this complete lack of responsibility, his unresponsiveness and belligerence following Monday's missed court date, were all cause for us to request \$ 4,500.00 of the \$ 5,000.00 paid him, allowing \$ 500 for the 1 arraignment appearance. Andrew walked him through the multiple issues legally with his "representation". Also, it was confirmed by Andrew that Mr Losson NEVER filed a notice of appearance for the felony case on the 19th. Mr Losson said it " must have fallen through ".

At this point Mr Losson was livid .He stated "what's your threat?" " I cannot refund it,I don't have the money". Andrew asked how much time he needed to do so ,he said he had no idea. As Andrew tried again to summarize the legal and professional issues in the matter, Mr Losson stated "stop talking or I'm hanging up". Andrew said we are trying to provide you an off ramp here with an amicable resolution. Mr Losson hung up the phone.

In summary, we paid this attorney for work he promised to perform and did not. He showed up only for the arraignment and never gave me counsel on the serious charges I face. He failed to even register with any notices of appearance. In the end ,he could not even say yes to being in good standing with the Bar. He cursed his clients instead of helping them. His behavior was beyond unprofessional and 100 % consistent right down to the last call that he disconnected from today.

In his final text today after I notified him he does not represent me , he did not even grasp that Monday is not an arraignment , but rather a pre-trial hearing. He said " I will be at your arraignment". Again, unprepared, unprofessional and now lecturing me on my decision to dismiss him. (6)

I hope to find some solace by exposing this lawyer to prevent others from the harm I have experienced. I also seek \$ 4,500.00 of my payment refunded.

Please accept this letter as my response to the complaint filed by Eric Bonderud. Mr. Bonderud contacted me about representing him on case filed in circuit court. I met Mr. Bonderud at the arraignment and my understanding was that I would represent him for the felony case number.

Mr. Bonderud also had a separate misdemeanor/traffic county court case that I was not aware of initially. The initial discussion centered on the circuit court case which I recall being difficult to find in the clerk system. According to the text message (exhibit 6) which Mr. Bonderud included with this complaint, he notified me on a Sunday night of this misdemeanor/traffic case set for 1:30 PM the next day, Monday December 12, 2022. I did respond that I would take care of this additional case for him and I did have him scheduled on my calendar for Monday December 12, 2022 in the afternoon. I had an injunction hearing scheduled for December 12 at 8:30 and I fully expected to be completed with my morning business so that I could handle Mr. Bonderud's case in the afternoon. My injunction case was continued in to the afternoon on December 12. This was unexpected and I was notified late morning that my injunction case would be rescheduled for the afternoon. Due to this unforeseen circumstance, I was unable to appear for Mr. Bonderud even though I had told him I would take care of it. The court continued Mr. Bonderud's case for him and there was no capias issued. Again, the money paid by the client in this case contemplated the felony case.

I was contacted by Mr. Bonderud regarding the missed court date for his traffic court case and I attempted to explain to him that something must have fallen through the cracks and that I would fix the situation.
